

Posters and abstracts guideline



Poster session is always the very important part of the **BCI: Science & Practice** conference that allows all participants to present and discuss their ideas and results.

Presenting a poster provides you with an opportunity to engage with other attendees, share your research, receive feedback and start conversations that may lead to future collaboration. Your poster enables you to discuss very specific aspects of your work.

To participate in poster session, you must submit your abstract to committee@bcisamara.com before **24 May 2019**. By 1 July the Program Committee will let you know if your abstract is accepted.

The poster and the abstract must be in English language.

The Program Committee reserves the right to offer the authors of the best poster abstracts to make a section report.

Abstract guideline

Title section must contain title, authors and affiliation, contact information (email), keywords.

The main section must not exceed 1800 symbols (including spaces) and cover purpose, main study design, results and conclusion.

Maximum 6 numbered references may be added at the end of the document. Citations in text must be braced: [1], [2] etc.

Poster guideline

Once your abstract is accepted please prepare your poster with the template provided by Organizing Committee at www.bcisamara.com. The organizers will print your poster and fix it on stand (portrait orientation only, template cannot be rotated).

The main header font size must be at least 70 pt., authors information, sections headers – 30 pt., main text 24 pt., figures captions – 20 pt. Each figure size must be at least 148*210 mm (landscape or portrait). All the illustrations must take at least 60% of the whole poster space.

Please note that content placed in the lower portion of the board can be not easy for other conferees to see.
