

Abstracts and posters guideline



Poster session is always a very important part of **BCI: Science & Practice** conference that allows many participants to present and discuss their ideas and results.

Presenting a poster provides an opportunity to engage with other attendees, share research details and specific aspects, receive feedback and start conversations that may lead to future collaboration.

To participate in poster session, a participant must upload an abstract using the button at a conference website (see it at the bottom of 2019 tab) before *extended deadline* - **30 June 2019**.

By 1 July the Program Committee will let know if the abstract is accepted those submitted before first deadline (24 May 2019). By 1 August we will inform those submitted from 24 May to 30 June.

The Program Committee reserves the right to offer authors of the best abstracts to make an oral section report.

In order to be included in proceedings, invited talks and oral section reports abstracts must be submitted too, in accordance with this guideline, by **31 August 2019**. Invited and sections speakers willing to include their slides in video published at the conference YouTube channel, must present them to the Organizing Committee by **20 September 2019**.

Abstract guideline

Only *.pdf, *.doc, *.docx files can be uploaded. The abstract filename can be in Latin symbols only (no Cyrillic), must start with *BCISamara2019* and contain first author's last name, initials and submission date separated by hyphens, e.g.: *BCISamara2019-PetrovAV-22May2019.pdf*

The abstract must be in English language. Title section must contain title, authors and affiliation, contact information (email), keywords.

The main section must not exceed 1800 symbols (including spaces) and cover purpose, main study design, results and conclusion.

Maximum 6 numbered references may be added at the end of the document. Citations in text must be braced: [1], [2] etc.

Poster guideline

Once the abstract is accepted for poster session please prepare a poster with the *.pptx template that will be provided by Organizing Committee at www.bcisamara.com by 10 August and upload it using a button at the conference website by **20 September 2019**. Only hi-resolution *.pdf files less than 15 Mb can be uploaded. The organizers will print a poster and fix it on a stand.

The poster must be in English language. The main header font size must be at least 70 pt., authors information, sections headers – 30 pt., main text 24 pt., figures captions – 20 pt. Each figure size must be at least 148*210 mm (landscape or portrait). All the illustrations must take at least 60% of the whole poster space. Poster must be portrait-oriented only - template cannot be rotated.

The poster filename can be in Latin symbols only (no Cyrillic), must start with *BCISamara2019_Poster* and contain first author's last name, initials and submission date separated by hyphens, e.g.: *BCISamara2019_Poster-PetrovAV-22Aug2019.pdf*

Please note that content placed in the lower portion of the board can be not easy for other conferees to see.
