

Abstracts and posters guideline



Poster sessions are always a very important part of **BCI Samara** that allow participants to present and discuss their ideas and results.

Presenting a poster provides you with an opportunity to engage with other attendees, share your research, receive feedback and start conversations that may lead to future collaboration. Your poster enables you to discuss very specific aspects of your work.

To participate in a poster session you must:

- register as a conference participant at the conference website and indicate there you are submitting an abstract;
- upload your abstract at the conference website before **31 May 2020**.

By **1 July 2020** the Program Committee will let you know if the abstract is accepted, reserving the right to offer authors of the best abstracts to deliver an oral section report.

Abstract guideline

Only *.pdf, *.doc, *.docx files can be uploaded. The abstract filename can be in Latin symbols only (no Cyrillic), must start with *BCISamara2020* and contain first author's last name, initials and submission date separated by hyphens, e.g.: *BCISamara2020-PetrovAV-22May2020.pdf*

The abstract must be in English language. Title section must contain title, authors and affiliation, contact information (email), keywords. **We strongly advise you to indicate your phone number when registering as a conference participant to make sure the Program Committee can contact you in a need.**

The main section must not exceed 1800 symbols (including spaces) and cover purpose, main study design, results and conclusion.

Maximum 6 numbered references may be added at the end of the document. Citations in text must be braced: [1], [2] etc.

Poster guideline

Once your abstract is accepted please prepare your poster with the *.pptx template that will be provided by the Organizing Committee at www.bcisamara.com by **1 July** and upload it at the conference website by **10 September 2020**. The organizers will print your poster and fix it on a stand.

The poster must be in English language. The main header font size must be at least 70 pt., authors information, sections headers – 30 pt., main text 24 pt., figures captions – 20 pt. Each figure size must be at least 148*210 mm (landscape or portrait). All the illustrations must take at least 60% of the whole poster space. Poster must be portrait- oriented only - template cannot be rotated.

Please note that content placed in the lower portion of the board can be not easy for other conferees to see.
